Access by plane

Bologna Airport (70 km from Reggio Emilia) Guglielmo Marconi Airport, in Bologna, is the largest airport close to Reggio Emilia. Info: www.bologna-airport.it

Access from Bologna Airport to Reggio Emilia: By train: Marconi Express Bologna Shuttle takes you to Bologna Station in 7 min; from there you can catch a train to both Reggio Emilia AV Mediopadana and Reggio Emilia Railway Stations.

By car: about 50 mins on the A1 motorway.

Milano Malpensa Airport (200 km from Reggio) Malpensa is Italy's second largest airport and a major international hub.
